19.046 Agenda: Mr. Beck reviewed the proposed Agenda and requested the addition of the ratification of the decision to increase the survey cost limits under Capital Projects.

Following discussion, upon motion duly made by Director Kemmeries, seconded by Director Henney and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the Agenda was approved as amended.

19.047 Minutes: The Board discussed the minutes of the March 20, 2019 Regular Meeting.

Following discussion, upon motion duly made by Director Kemmeries, seconded by Director Henney and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the minutes of the March 20, 2019 meeting were approved as presented.

19.048 Public Comment: There were no public comments.

LEGAL MATTERS

19.049 Consider approval of updated SDMS Management Contract: Attorney Flynn reported that he is still working on the revision and will report back to the Board at the May meeting.

19.050 OCCT/Denver Water Update: Attorney Flynn reported that Denver Water is now exploring the feasibility of providing kits to remove lead from water in the lines of homes with lead pipes.

FINANCIAL MATTERS

19.051 Approval of Claims: Mr. Beck reviewed with the Board the claims for the period ending March 20, 2019 as follows:

19.052 Unaudited Financial Statements: Mr. Beck reviewed the unaudited financial statements for the period ending March 31, 2019, and the cash position statement dated as of March 31, 2019.

Following discussion, upon motion duly made by Director Kemmeries, seconded by Director Henney and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the unaudited financial statements for the period ending March 31, 2019, and the cash position statement dated as of March 31, 2019, were accepted, with the understanding that Mr. Beck will check into the spreadsheet formulas, which showed a zero percent of budget expenditures for some line items where in fact expenditures had occurred.

OPERATIONS

19.053 Grease Trap Inspections and Operations: Mr. Beck reported that there was not a grease trap report for the month but that DRC had completed videoing a large section of pipe and had provided the videos for review.

CAPITAL PROJECTS 19.054 2019 Capital Projects: Mr. Raatz updated the Board on his review of the lines and the survey project for the line on South Holly between Yale and Jersey Streets. He noted that the survey work is scheduled to begin next week. He is

reviewing the Capital Projects options and will be in a better position to provide the Board with a recommendation, once the survey has been completed.

19.055 <u>Manholes and Options for Repair and/or Replacement:</u> Mr. Raatz discussed the engagement of Flatirons to perform the survey and the associated costs which exceeded the original estimate of \$6,000.00.

19.056 <u>Survey Costs</u>: Mr. Beck discussed the increased costs and the discussions with Director Henney and Attorney Flynn and the authorization given to Mr. Raatz by Director Henney to accept the higher cost of approximately \$7,000.00.

Following discussion, upon motion duly made by Director Sullivan, seconded by Director Kemmeries and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the Board ratified the authorization of Mr. Raatz to proceed with the survey at the increased cost of approximately \$7,000.00.
